CELLBADGE ID SYSTEM!

Starting in January 2021, Northwest Crossing implemented a new ID Card system. CellBadge is a safe security badging application that uses your smart phone as your ID card, replacing the old plastic badge.

If you are ready to get started just follow the steps below:

- 1.Log into NWCrossing.cellbadge.com
- 2.To register, select "Initial Add Request" and you will receive a PIN number, log in using that PIN and then enter your last name, address, phone number, emergency phone number, and e-mail address.
- 3.All information will be confirmed and approved by an administrator and you will be sent a confirmation email. For the first year, an administrator will need to add your photo. Please send photos to nwc@nwchoa.org and attach proof of residence for all adults (18+) in the household.
- 4.Once operational, you will be able to use your smart phone to access pools, tennis courts, clubhouses, and parks.
