#### Emergency Preparation & Safety Tips Don't wait for an emergency or power outage, make a family emergency plan now.

#### **BASIC DISASTER SUPPLIES KIT**

To assemble your kit, store items in airtight plastic bags and put your entire disaster supplies kit in one or two easy-to-carry containers such as plastic bins or a duffel bag. **<u>Ready.gov/kit</u>** is a good source for emergency kit information and supply lists.

A basic emergency supply kit could include the following **recommended items:** 

- Water (one gallon per person per day for several days, for drinking and sanitation)
- Food (at least a several-day supply of non-perishable food)
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert
- Flashlight
- First aid kit
- Extra batteries
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Dust mask (to help filter contaminated air)
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape (to shelter in place)
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties (for personal sanitation)
- Wrench or pliers (to turn off utilities)
- Manual can opener (for food)
- Local maps
- Cell phone with chargers and a backup battery
- Pet food and extra water for your pet


