From time to time, folks ask about why the HOA cannot pay for USPS cluster box replacement. The short answer: It is against State Law, specifically Texas Property Code Chapter 209 Title II Restrictive Covenants. It prevents HOAs from spending your Annual Assessment dollars on anything not owned by the HOA. Real property, such as, pools, picnic areas, playing fields, etc. are HOA owned, but mailboxes, individual or cluster, do not fit that definition.




2026 Annual Homeowner's Meeting Overview





Save MONEY, File Your Homestead Exemption

I helped a homeowner request ALL their exemptions and save about \$6100!

For example, a home worth around \$310,000, property taxes are about \$7,135 per year without exemptions, based on Bexar County's average 2.30% rate. After filing your homestead exemption, your tax bill could drop to about \$4,121, and that is a major yearly savings that really adds up.

If you file late, you can usually get a refund for up to two years for regular, age-65, or disabled exemptions. Disabled veterans may qualify for up to five years of refunds. (Source: BCAD.org)
